Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

The working team composed of all project partners, following the input of the University of Bologna lead beneficiary of this WP, defined how to create and disseminate some short videos based on the activities realized by the project partners in these months.

Some groups chose to make a video representing the overall activities carried out at the local level with the project, while others preferred to focus on a specific activity, which they considered more significant (e.g. historical research, trip and experience in Auschwitz-Birkenau, outcome of workshops, holocaust...).

In total, eight video clips were produced and presented at events, meetings, secondary school and university lectures in order to convey the memory of the Porrajmos through the voices of the protagonists, to raise awareness among the younger generations and the general public, and to disseminate anti-discrimination messages through art (drawing, graffiti, theatre and the production of animated videos...).
