RIBALTAMBICAO (Portugal - Figueira da Foz)	O6/02/2024, 20/02/2024: the invisible Roma Holocaust  Two training sessions for teachers on Roma History and culture (total 10 hours) were held at the Figueira da Foz Vocational School, focusing on the invisible Roma holocaust. The lack of knowledge about Roma history and culture and even more about the invisible holocaust became apparent. The training sessions created a lot of debate, although prejudice and the crystallization of prejudices is visible among education agents.	11 participants
