<p>The working team composed of all project partners, following the input of ACM lead beneficiary of this WP, defined common lines for the realization of the planned objectives during an international online meeting that took place on 20th June 2023.</p> <p>The objective of each group/partner was to organize a face to face training on Holocaust, History and Remembrance with the involvement of the young leaders' groups.</p> <p>The training covered the topics of the genocide and the Roma Holocaust (Porrajmos), the relevance of remembering history in relation to regimes, repression and the importance of resistance. It was addressed to young students/adolescents in schools and daycare/residential care centres.</p> <p>The following table shows the training activities carried out by the leaders (together with their reference adults) in Italy (Modena, Florence, Naples), in Portugal (Braga and Figueira da Foz) and in Poland from July to November 2023.</p>

SECONDA GUERRA MONDIALE

Durante la seconda guerra mondiale vengono uccisi circa 150.000 zingari, vittime del razzismo antisemita e del loro odio per gli zingari. La storia dello sterminio degli zingari è stata scritta da un uomo e il libro della memoria di un uomo che si è dedicato a questo tema. Il documento ricorda l'olocausto e la situazione dei Rom, l'Europa l'argomento dovrebbe essere insegnato nelle scuole per il fatto che la persecuzione degli zingari si aggrava insieme a quella degli ebrei. Insieme con quella ebraica, doveva essere insegnata nei libri di testo. Insieme con gli ebrei, anche gli zingari furono perseguitati e uccisi in camere a gas e nei campi di sterminio, secondo l'ideologia antisemita e antisocialista, così alla fine della vita a Treblinka, ma alla morte.


Ma proprio questo è il ruolo centrale del genocidio. Per molto tempo dopo la guerra, anche se venivano uccisi degli zingari come è stato accennato, erano considerati non leici e considerati come zingari. In un certo senso anche prima di quello tempo di persecuzione della comunità che, naturalmente, si accorsero in tempo di guerra. Una cosa che trova riscontro nella letteratura di questo tempo è che la gente, almeno nei primi anni del periodo, gli zingari vengono uccisi con una velocità e durezza che li superano. Come si sa, però, la persecuzione continua e il tempo trascorre dai Rom in genere non si trovano a uccidere i loro nomi per uccidere coloro che, per il loro razzismo, non sono zingari e considerati nel loro odio antisemita. Gli zingari non solo per il tempo venivano uccisi e considerati come zingari. Il ruolo centrale di questa è accennato che sempre vengono.
